



Festive Felt Ornaments & Decorations

A BAREFOOT ACTIVITY FOR KIDS AGES 6 AND UP

Are you looking for a fun craft activity to keep your children occupied this festive season? All you need is some felt, cardstock, ribbon and glue to make these simple decorations in the shape of a bird, dreidel, star and tree.

QUANTITY 5 sheets of felt makes about 4 double-sided decorations

WHAT TO FIND

- 5 Letter-sized sheets of felt in the colors of your choice
- Cardstock for templates
- Scissors
- Glue and tape
- 40" Ribbon
- Marker
- Sequins, beads and more

WHAT TO DO

1. Print the attached sheet of templates on card stock and cut out the shapes.
2. Trace the shapes onto felt using a marker. Make sure you draw each shape twice to make a double-sided decoration.
3. If you'd like to create a hanging ornament, cut 10" of ribbon, fold into a loop and tape the ends to the cardstock.
4. Cut out and glue the felt shapes onto both sides of the cardstock. Make sure you glue down the sides that have marker lines on them.
5. Use sequins, beads and off-cuts from other felt pieces to add to your decoration. Experiment with stripes, spots and other patterns!
